#### 1. Covelo

Registered Credential School Nurse services for 2023-2024 are needed in the district to train, monitor, and supervise specialized health care procedures, coordinate student health care, screen vision and hearing, and provide special education assessments. Traditional recruiting has not been successful in securing employees and as services are required by law, it is recommended the Board approve the outside service agreement. Health Services Coordinator will train new school nurse (14 days). Contract not to exceed \$10,640, funding is Medi-Cal 9012 (restricted funds).

- 2. Registered Credential School Nurse services for 2024-2025 are needed in the district to train, monitor, and supervise specialized health care procedures, coordinate student health care, screen vision and hearing, and provide special education assessments. Traditional recruiting has not been successful in securing employees and as services are required by law, it is recommended the Board approve the outside service agreements. Continue prior contracts totaling 0.8 FTE, plus replacement of Health Services Coordinator, 1.0 FTE with a School Nurse 1.0 FTE. Funding: 0.8 FTE: split 50/50 special ed 6500/Medi-Cal 9012, not to exceed \$100,000.
