e) RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE CALAVERAS UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT ORDERING A SCHOOL BOND ELECTION, AND AUTHORIZING NECESSARY ACTIONS IN CONNECTION THEREWITH

<u>SUMMARY:</u> State law requires the Board of Trustees to order school district elections. The County Registrar of Voters will conduct the election on behalf of the District, including publishing all required notices. This Resolution Calling the Election (the "Resolution") must contain the exact language of the bond proposition in the "specifications of the election order." Under Proposition 39, which permits passage of the measure upon a 55% "yes" vote, certain additional matters must be addressed in the bond measure, including a specific project list to be funded from the bonds. Exhibit A to the Resolution contains the "bond project list." A 75-word summary of the measure, to appear on the ballots, is included in the Resolution.

Exhibit B to the Resolution is the "Tax Information Statement," which must be included in the ballot pamphlet, describing the best estimates of the average annual tax rate, the highest tax rate, and the total debt service on the bonds.

Following adoption, the resolution must be delivered to the County Registrar of Voters and the
