#### 1. Pro Care Therapy

After conducting a diligent search for paraprofessionals, the district is recommending that the Board approve the contract with Pro Care Therapy to contract Ashley Kuntz for paraprofessional services which will be funded through Special Education. Fill behind position number 417.

#### 2. Access Communications - Speech Therapy Services

It is requested the Board approve the contract with Access Communications in order to provide Speech-Language Pathology services to CUSD students for the 2023-2024 school year. Services to include assessments, IEP case management, and in-person speech therapy for our most vulnerable students. This contract replaces previously contracted virtual speech services (with Soliant) for this school year. The cost will not exceed fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000).
